



## Getting started!

### **Experience the Århus of the Vikings via your mobile telephone with the drama HIKUIN's Vendetta**

The Viking drama takes place at the 12 locations in the central area of Århus described in this information screen. To ensure that the drama is narrated correctly according to your position in the city, you need to install a programme in your mobile telephone. This programme is used to scan TAGs (bar codes) at the 12 locations, and to install the programme and download sound and images to your mobile telephone you must complete 3 steps:

#### **1. Download the mobile programme to read the 12 TAGs in the streets of Århus**

Send a text message to 1231 with the text 'HIKUIN' in order to install the mobile programme in your mobile telephone. It is free of charge, and only costs the rate that your telephone company charges for data traffic.

**Or:** You can switch on Bluetooth on your mobile telephone and accept the message that we send you via Bluetooth.

In both cases you then just follow the links on your mobile telephone.

#### **2. Download sound- and image files**

When you have accepted the programme and open it for the first time, you need to download sound- and image files to your mobile telephone. The transfer is initiated by opening the programme in your programme folder. From here you follow the instructions in your mobile telephone, and choose in which way you want to download the files:

- via Bluetooth, which necessitates that you have your mobile telephone within short distance of this information screen - the closer you are to the screen, the faster the download will be. (It may last 5-10 minutes).

- via network (3G/WI-FI), you can search for a WI-FI with the name Hikuin **or** you can download the files via 3G. (It last approximately 2 minutes).

The download is free of charge, and only costs the rate that your telephone company charges for the selection of 3G.



### **3. Experience HIKUIN's Vendetta by scanning TAGs**

To experience the drama, you must scan the 12 TAGs (bar codes) at the locations - this is what you do:

1. Open the scanner. (This is often found under "programme folder" in your mobile telephone).
2. Scan the TAG. This is done in the same way as when you take a photograph with the camera. Hold your telephone approximately 20 centimetres from the TAG, and make sure that you scan the whole TAG.
3. The telephone now decodes the TAG, and you will be able to hear and see the part of the drama which fits with your location. The first bar code is found at the Viking Museum.
